You will explore Web page management in-depth, create internal and external Cascading Style Sheets, integrate behaviours with layers, create image maps, open windows, use Dreamweaver templates, add sound and Flash elements and much more. In addition, you will cover custom JavaScript functions, edit in the code view editor and learn to write custom JavaScript functions that merge seamlessly with Dreamweaver code.
