Course Content:

- Preference Settings: document and printing presets, workspace settings, library set-up, defining colours, hyphenation
- Advanced Text linking
- Enhanced Typography Controls: using paragraph nested styles, advanced bullets & numbering, finding/replacing fonts, optical margin alignment, paragraph composer, defining object styles, using the eyedropper tool, quick apply feature, open type and glyph sets, special characters, text variables
- Layers
- Images and Graphics: image frames, text frames for images, applying effects to images, colouring grayscale images, anchoring objects, nested graphics
- Outline Type
- Effects: object styles, drop shadows, feathering, corner effects, transparency effects
- Pathfinder
- Convert Shape
- Corner Options
- Paths & Shapes: Using the Pen tool, working with the Pathfinder panel
- Importing Files: from Adobe Photoshop, setting layer visibility for Photoshop files, placing text and paths from Adobe Illustrator
